

VILLAGE CENTER AND POOL RULES

Pool hours are 10 A.M. to 8 P.M. daily, weather permitting. **If anyone is spotted after hours, please contact the North Cornwall Township Police at 274-0464.**

The pool is for Creekside homeowners and their guests only.

- A guest is a non-resident person accompanied by a homeowner. If Creekside is not your permanent address, you are a guest. Homeowners' children, grandchildren, and babysitters who do not reside in Creekside are considered guests.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Creekside resident 13 years or older. The exception is a babysitter or guardian of children of a homeowner. Babysitters and guardians who are registered and using a parent's pool tag do not have to pay a guest fee. To register a babysitter, see the pool attendant.
- All homeowners and their guests must be signed in by the pool attendant.
- Guest fees must be paid at time of visit:
 - Ages 4 and older: \$ 4.00 per day
 - Under age 4: No charge
 - 10-visit punch card: \$30
- A household may bring a maximum of 4 guests at a time. Homeowners must request approval 48 hours in advance in order to bring more than 4 guests at a time. Please contact Brenda Boyer at Horst Property Management (bboyer@HorstGroup.com)

Entrance to the Village Center and pool is granted to Creekside residents during pool hours by showing a pool tag. One pool tag is issued upon request to each Creekside resident 4 years and older. If lost, replacement tags are available for purchase from the pool attendant for a fee of \$10 (check only, no cash). Tags will be inactive for homeowners who move, have lost privileges for disciplinary reasons, or who are delinquent on assessment or other fees.

No private parties are allowed at the Village Center without written permission from the Board of Directors. You may not close off an area for your party.

1. Running, DIVING, horseplay (throwing hard balls, doing flips, etc), and foul/offensive language is strictly prohibited.
2. Anyone deliberately damaging pool furniture or pool structures or trespassing after hours will automatically lose pool privileges for an indefinite period and be reported to the proper authorities.
3. No weapons or illegal substances are allowed in the Village Center, pool, or surrounding areas. Individuals who violate this policy will be permanently banned from the pool and will be reported to the proper authorities.
5. No loud music permitted at the pool. Please be considerate of others.
6. No glass items, alcoholic beverages, or tobacco products permitted at the pool.
7. Infants and children who are not toilet trained MUST wear swim diapers covered with plastic pants in the pool. Feces accidents require the pool to shut down for 24 hours. Please report accidents immediately to the pool attendant.
8. No cut offs (jeans/shorts) in the pool. Loose threads clog the filter/pump.
9. You must be 13 years of age or older to be at the pool without adult supervision. *If you are 12 years or younger, you must be accompanied by a babysitter or guardian. Children 6 years or younger must be accompanied by an adult in the locker/bathroom areas.*
10. Footwear is recommended inside the Village Center at all times.
11. No pets permitted in the pool area, inside the Village Center, or on the tennis court.
12. No bikes in the Village Center or inside the fence surrounding the pool. Please use the bike rack.
13. No rollerblades, scooters, bikes, or skateboards on tennis/basketball courts or in the pool area.
14. Playground equipment is for children 10 years and younger.

Homeowners are responsible for behavior of their children and guests, regardless of age. Please respect the rights of others to use the pool. If violations of these rules occur, please notify the pool attendant.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

Violations are subject to the Villages of Creekside HOA Enforcement Policy. Serious or repeat infractions will result in the loss of privileges from the pool and Village Center for the homeowners' entire family for up to 12 months by order of the Board of Directors.
