

VILLAGE CENTER AND POOL RULES

The pool is for Creekside homeowners and their guests only.

- A guest is defined as a non-resident person accompanied by a homeowner. If Creekside is not your permanent address, you are a guest. Homeowners' children, grandchildren, and babysitters who do not reside in Creekside are considered guests.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Creekside homeowner. The exception is a babysitter or guardian, age 18 or older, of children of a homeowner. Babysitters and guardians must still pay a guest fee.
- All homeowners must sign in themselves AND their guests daily. Attendance records are required by the state.
- Guest fees will be billed monthly as follows:

Ages 11 and older:	\$ 3.00 per day
Ages 4–10:	\$ 2.00 per day
Under Age 4:	No charge

Pool hours are 10 A.M. to 9 P.M. daily through July (weather permitting). Beginning August 1, the pool will close at 8 P.M. No one—including a resident—is allowed in the pool area or inside the Village Center after the pool is closed. If anyone is spotted after hours, please contact the North Cornwall Township Police at 274-0464.

Access to the Village Center is granted to Creekside homeowners during pool hours by use of a key card. The Recreation Committee issues one key card upon request to Creekside homeowners. Replacement and/or duplicate cards cost \$10. Keys are disabled for homeowners who move, lose keys, or are locked out for disciplinary reasons. A new card will be issued for \$10 when privileges are restored to a homeowner locked out for non-payment of fees, disciplinary action, etc.

No private parties are allowed at the Village Center without written permission from the Recreation Committee. You may not close off an area for your party. To reserve the meeting room for a party, please contact a Recreation Committee member. Trash must be cleaned up and removed.

1. The rope dividing the shallow end and the deep end of the pool must be connected at all times.
2. No diving, running, or general horseplay (throwing balls in the pool, doing flips, etc) for safety reasons.
3. No glass items, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, or loud music permitted at the pool.
4. Infants and toddlers not toilet trained MUST wear swim diapers covered with plastic pants in the pool.
5. No cut offs (jeans/shorts) in the pool.
6. You must be 13 years of age or older to be at the pool without adult supervision. *If you are 12 years or younger, you must be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age. Children 6 years or younger must be accompanied by an adult in the locker/bathroom areas.*
7. Footwear is recommended inside the Village Center at all times.
8. Please remove all umbrellas from the stands at the pool when not in use.
9. No pets permitted in the pool area, inside the Village Center, or on the tennis/basketball courts.
10. No bikes in the pool house or inside the fence surrounding the pool. Please use the bike rack.
11. No rollerblades, scooters, bikes, or skateboards on tennis/basketball courts or in the pool area.

Homeowners are responsible for the behavior of their children and guests, regardless of age. If violations of these rules occur, please contact a member of the Recreation Committee.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

1. First and second violations will receive a verbal and/or written warning from the Recreation Committee.
2. Third violation will result in the loss of privileges from the pool and Village Center for the homeowners' entire family for the remainder of the pool season.
